CONSTRUCTION HAS BEGUN

New structure construction started; existing house renovation starts 2023

With the help of 649 loyal donors who pledged over \$9.89 million, the only thing left is to renovate the existing house and build the new study pavilion! These new and renovated facilities will help ensure Delta Tau Delta remains a premier fraternity at the University of Texas. We on the building committee are strongly anticipating this new home for our brothers, as I'm sure our alumni are, and we have a few updates to share on obstacles in our way and what can be expected in the future.

We have experienced a few issues that have prevented us from breaking ground right away. It has been difficult to secure permits, particularly during COVID-19, which has been a primary cause of the delay. Additionally, the city of Austin continues to be overwhelmed with the amount of construction in the area.

Furthermore, building restrictions have been further modified by the city of Austin, creating more complexity for any development in flood zones. This has proven to be an issue for us, as about one-eighth of the existing Shelter was built on a floodplain. With these delays in construction, we plan to begin work on the main structure in the summer of 2023. The existing structure renovation is targeted to be complete prior to the start of the fall 2024 semester; however, we do not have a specific timeline yet.

While we have had to modify our plans slightly, there is something else we can look forward to—our new lot/study pavilion and a reoriented sports court! **That's right, the building committee finalized the contract in early May and construction has begun.** The goal is to have these completed by the Alabama game this fall, barring any major delays.

While we have experienced more complications than we had hoped in expanding our Shelter, we look forward to beginning construction next summer. Thank you for your continued support of Gamma Iota; it's because of our loyal alumni that we are able to complete this project. We will keep you updated are more information becomes available.
